- 1. Click â€Ctrl+F3â€[™], then â€Name Managerâ€[™] Box Appears
- 2. Click â€Newâ€[™] (use shortcut key Alt+N)
- **3.** Then, â€New nameâ€[™] box appears
- 4. Enter â€Nameâ€[™] as "CountSheets"(Your choice)
- 5. Enter â€Refer Toâ€[™] as =GET.WORKBOOK(1)&T(NOW())
- 6. Click OK
- 7. It takes you to the â€Name Managerâ€[™] box again (you can find the Defined Name in the list)
- 8. Click â€Close'
- 9. Come to the Cell, where you want to enter the Formula
